KID’S TOWN, Now Aunty Carols Kids City, formerly, Birch Acres After School Centre, has been caring for the children of Kempton Park since 1982. Our policy is to encourage children to feel that they are part of a large and happy family, and the atmosphere is one of friendship and love.

Hours of care: 06h30 – 17h30. Late collection will result in an extra charge being levied.

A mid-morning snack is served at 10h00 with a drink. Lunch is served at 12h30 to all children who attend the centre.

Please make sure that all your child’s belongings are clearly marked with their name. This avoids property being mislaid and enables us to return the items to the right child immediately.

The centre is open all school holidays, except December, with a programme of entertainment provided each holiday. We do encourage you to send your child during the school holidays, as this is a time when they learn to socialize with each other and experience the fun of group outings and entertainment. Outings are optional. Parents will be required to pay the extra cost involved.

AUNTY CAROLS KIDS CITY SUPPORTS TUMELO HOME.

A home for physically and mentally disabled children situated in Ivory Park. The Centre has a staff compliment of 42 which consist of the following, auxiliary nurse, outsourced Occupational Therapist, Caregivers, Gardener, Cook and Helper. The Centre operates 24 hours.

Tumelo is registered as NPO/PBO through the Department of Health and as such they have numerous challenges when it comes to running the centre which relies heavily on donations. (Kids City has been involved in fund raising and collection of clothes and food for this wonderful home for over 25 years).

The educational challenges are that there are currently no structured/formal education programmes that are designed for the children, however the Centre runs stimulation programmes which are facilitated by the staff. This is not enough since the children are physically and mentally handicapped and need special programmes that will empower them, not withstanding regulations governing what should be taught at these special Centres.

The Centre needs resources for the daily running of the Centre and the following have been identified, nappies, washing machine powder, food, soap, toilet paper, medicines, seeds, manure/fertilizer, clothing and bedding for the children.

The Centre has its own vegetable garden. The money allocated by the Government is not enough to maintain the Centre and the children's needs. Therefore, Sponsors and well wishes are greatly valued.

Once a year, Kids City plans an outing for parents who are interested to visit the home and its children.



SCHOOL FEES

A **registration** fee of **R 300** is payable on application.

An annual **re-registration** fee of **R 100** is payable end November.

All fees are payable in **advance**, over **12 months** and must be received by 3rd of each month. A **penalty of R100** will be charged for late payments.

EFT Payment:

ATM Cardless Deposit:

This can be done at the ATM by using the Aunty Carols Kids City account details. Please use your ***Child's name & surname*** as reference.

Card payment:

There is a debit card machine available between 07h00 and 17h30.

Cash:

If possible, please do your best to use one of the above methods of payment for security reasons.

TUCK SHOP: Each class has a day once a week when the children go shopping. An amount of between R2 and R5 per week is enough and does not need to be given every week. As the children bring in money, it is recorded on a register and when it is their day to shop, they are called up to buy their sweets or chips.

RULES AND REGULATIONS.

- Fees must be paid in advance by the 3rd of each month for a period of 12 months. (January – December). **A penalty of R150 will be charged for late payments.** If fees are overdue, we reserve the right to suspend your Child until the fees are paid.
- All Children must be signed out when collected by a Parent or Transport*.
- If your child is leaving the centre, one month's written notice is required.
- **No refund will be made if your child is unable to attend the centre for any reason.**
- Parents are to inform us if their child is to be collected by anyone other than themselves.
- The Centre is open from 06h30 to 17h30. Late collection will result in an extra charge being levied.
- Please ensure that your child is at school no later than 08h00. All children must be dropped off and collected inside the gate of Kids City.
- Medicines must be handed to a member of staff for safe keeping and administering.
- Please inform us of any change of personal details such as address, telephone numbers or medical aid details.
- Please mark all your child's clothing and personal belongings with his/her name, this makes it easier to return lost property to the correct person and avoids a lot of unnecessary heartache for all concerned.
- It is compulsory for each child to have the Kids City school bag with a change of clothing every day and to wear their school uniform.
- The Centre closes on the last day of the fourth term, no holiday care is provided during December.



SCHOOL HOLIDAYS.

All children are required to be marked off on the register as they arrive.

Children are entertained daily with activities such as:

- **Pick-A-Box Show**
- **Boerewors Braai**
- **Picnics**
- **Sports Day**
- **Beetle Drive**
- **Bingo**
- **DVD mornings.**

These activities always take place during the mornings. During the afternoons, the children can play with a teacher in attendance. The term schedule for lunch and cool drink time applies during school holidays.

We encourage children to participate in all activities and often allow the older children to supervise the entertainment with guidance from the staff. This gives them a sense of belonging and responsibility, which is especially important to their development. It provides them with a great sense of well-being and self-worth.

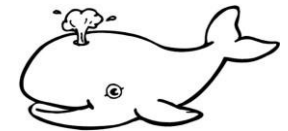

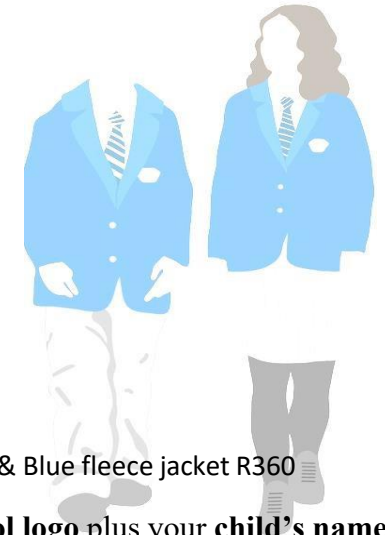
